Homework

Students will receive homework assignments that will range from independent reading, SOL review, and unfinished classwork. All assignments will be recorded in the student planner

Late Work

Late work must be submitted in a timely manner. All work is due one week prior to the end of the quarter when grades are due.

Explanation of Zeroes

A zero will be given for an assignment in which the student earns a 0. A zero in the gradebook indicates the assignment has been graded, but was either not turned in or earned zero credit. An X in the gradebook means the student is exempt from that assignment. A Z in the gradebook means the assignment was not turned in and currently not calculated in the total average; however, if the assignment is not turned in, a zero will be given.

Reassessment

All reassessment work will be managed using a reflection form - including remediation. Students can retake assessments (quizzes, projects, and tests) to improve their score.

Make-up Work

Make-up work will be accepted up to one week prior to the end of the quarter when grades are due.

Extra Credit

Extra credit will be given at the discretion of each teacher.
