Homework

- Classwork that is incomplete may be sent home for more time; this will be recorded as classwork in the grade book.
- Unit study guide reviews will be recorded in the grade book as homework. · Homework will not count more than 10% of the grade.

Late Work

- Late work will be accepted with a percentage deducted. The percent deducted will be shared with students when they receive the assignment.
- Late work will be accepted and graded up to one week prior to the end of the quarter when grades are due. Late work turned in after the due date will be accepted, but the grade will not be entered into the grade book.
- Due dates will be established and published in course expectations for the department.

Explanation of Zeroes

- Zeros will not be assigned in Social Studies class.
- Students will receive a grade for missing work; the score shall not exceed 50% of the assignment.
- Missing work will be reflected in the grade book immediately to accurately reflect the current grade (this will avoid leaving blanks in the grade book).
- If a student makes-up the work, the grade will reflect the most current knowledge and skills.

Reassessment

- All reassessment work will be managed using a reflection form.
 - Quizzes, projects, and tests: Students can re-do these to improve their score.
- Classwork & formative assessments: Will not be offered for retakes for an improved grade, however the teachers will use scores to re-teach and remediate as needed.

Make-up Work

- All work must be made up one week prior to the end of the quarter when grades are due.

Extra Credit

- Extra credit will be used as an enrichment opportunity.
- Extra credit will be awarded, but it shall not replace regularly assigned work or assessments.
- Extra credit is only available to students that have completed all regular assignments.
